



COCA SHOWCASES AT A GLANCE

Expose your act to the Canadian college and university market.

Founded in 1982, the Canadian Organization of Campus Activities (COCA) is the only association dedicated purely to campus activities programming in Canada.

The COCA National Conference provides an excellent opportunity for colleges & universities, booking agencies and self-represented artists to gather together, network, showcase, exhibit and conduct business. **More than 25 showcase opportunities are available** in various categories.

COCA is the place to be to get in front of Canadian campus activities planners! More than 130 student and staff buyers ("school" delegates) from approximately 60 schools across the country are expected to attend the **2015 COCA National Conference in Edmonton, Alberta June 8-12, 2015**. In addition, more than 70 "associate" delegates representing 40 companies and artists will be represented in the Campus Activities Biz Hall, COCA's trade show.

Artists that are selected to showcase must become COCA Associates or be represented by a company that is, or will become, a COCA Associate. All selected showcase acts must be represented in the trade show either by the act itself or by a company representing the act. Associate "status" and Associate "conference registration" (trade show) forms are available on the COCA Web site under Conferences – National Conference – 2015 National. See List of "Associate" forms at bottom of page. Showcasing at a COCA Conference involves several fees. If selected to showcase, you must pay all applicable fees by March 31, 2015. Attention Canadian Artists: There are a number of organizations such as FACTOR and provincial music industry associations that assist music artists with travel expenses involved with showcasing at "contact" events such as the COCA National Conference. Showcase Fees

For hard copy submissions, ALL applicable fees must be sent with the showcase application. Aside from the non-refundable showcase application fee, cheques for the actual showcase fee, the conference registration fee, and the associate status fee, will not be deposited by COCA unless the act is selected to showcase – please see document on fees and the hard copy application form on this site.
